I understand that this sport involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications and medical facilities.

I understand that these areas may have natural and manmade hazards which Management cannot anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate. I understand that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, unpredictable and dangerous and that accidents can happen at any time. I accept full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding. **Under Florida law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.** This release is valid for my animal(s), personal belongings, family members and/or any guest in my company.

Saturday, March 17, 2012

8 AM: Check-in

9 AM: Pre-race meeting (required)

A trail competition for individuals or teams of two or three people (minimum age 14). The relay legs are approximately:

- 7 miles on horseback
- 10 miles on mountain bike
- 3.5 miles of trail running

Race starts and finishes at the Cross Florida Greenway Land Bridge Trailhead, southwest of Ocala at 11100 SW 16th Ave. (CR 475A).

Entry Fees:

- Individual racer - \$30 per person
- Teams of 2 or 3 racers - \$20 per person
- Race day registration - \$30 per person

Safety gear required - buckled helmets for equestrians and bikers.

Equestrians must provide proof of current negative Coggins test (Chapter 5C-18.010, F.A.C).

- Ribbons are presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places for both teams and individuals.
- "Turtle award" for the last team to arrive!
- Participants receive a t-shirt, water bottle, commemorative wristband and a great day of competitive fun!

Weather Policy

The weather contingencies are in place for the safety of all relay participants (human and equine) and volunteers.

Rain Plan - Day of Race

Light Drizzle: If there is a light drizzle on the morning of the Relay, we will continue as planned and monitor the weather conditions until the start of the race.

If there is still a light drizzle as of 9:30 am, we will start the Relay. If weather conditions worsen during the race, the Ride-Roll-Run Relay Committee reserves the right to stop the event.

Hard Downpour, High Wind, Thunder, or Lightning: If there are dangerous weather conditions in the area as of 9 am, all participants and volunteers will be asked to move to a safe area until the weather clears. If the weather has cleared by 9:20 am, then all participants will proceed to the start line.

If dangerous weather conditions are still in effect as of 9:30-9:45 am, and do not appear likely to clear up within 10-15 minutes, it will be necessary to reschedule the event. The Committee reserves the right to delay or reschedule the race if weather conditions have created a high probability of downed trees. Since certain areas could become impassable, there may be a need to inspect the route. The final decision to proceed, delay, cancel or reschedule the race will be determined by the Ride-Roll-Run Relay Committee.

In the event that the Ride-Roll-Run Relay must be rescheduled, the rain date is set for April 7, 2012.
